## **ROUTE 101 & 102 TROLLEY CONSTRUCTION & MAINTENANCE** **SCHEDULED FOR AUGUST 15 – AUGUST 30**

*16 day work period will include signal upgrades and other maintenance.  
Shuttle buses will replace Trolleys from 69<sup>th</sup> Street to the end of each line.*

Routes 101 & 102 Improvement Project – Saturday, August 15 through Sunday, August 30



For two weeks, beginning on Saturday, August 15 and continuing through August 30, SEPTA and third-party contractors will be performing a variety of maintenance and construction activities at multiple locations along the Route 101 and 102 Trolley Lines.

This work on SEPTA's right-of-way will be performed during daylight hours, seven days a week over the 16-day work period concluding on Sunday, August 30. Planned work includes: signal improvements and testing, track replacement, catenary pole replacement and brush

cutting.

Residents living along both Routes 101 and 102 Trolley Lines may notice construction activity and sounds, including vehicle backup alerts and heavy machinery. Residents are reminded that even during construction, tracks should always be considered active, and the entire line should be considered an active construction zone.

### **Shuttle Bus Substitution –**

To allow crews to safely perform necessary improvements, **shuttle buses will operate in place of ALL Route 101 and 102 Trolleys between 69th Street Transportation Center and the end of each trolley route (Media: Route 101, and Sharon Hill: Route 102) from Saturday, August 15 through the end of the service day on Sunday, August 30.**
