SEWER CONNECTION PERMIT APPLICATION

In accordance with § 109-15 of the Code of Springfield Township:

- A. There is hereby imposed upon each owner of property connecting to the sanitary sewer system a tapping or connection charge of \$1,500 per E.D.U. (equivalent dwelling unit).
- B. For purposes of determining the number of E.D.U.s, the classifications on the reverse side of this form shall be used.
- C. In the event of a change in user classification of a commercial establishment where an increase in water consumption is projected, the new tenant will be responsible for the payment of a sewer tapping fee based on the net increase in E.D.U.'s.
- D. The tapping fee or connection charge shall be payable upon application for permit to make such connection.
