

**TOWNSHIP OF SPRINGFIELD
RESOLUTION NO. 10-2023**

**RESOLUTION PROVIDING AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH
AND MAINTAIN AN EMERGENCY SERVICES ACCOUNT FOR
TOWNSHIP FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Springfield, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, desire to establish an account to provide for a source of dedicated funding for capital and other unanticipated costs associated with Township Emergency Services i.e. Fire Company, Fire Marshal's Office, Emergency Medical Services and Office of Emergency Management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SPRINGFIELD, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY OF SAID COMMISSIONERS; THAT:

1. The proper officers of the Township of Springfield may execute such resolutions and documents necessary to establish and maintain a federally insured account with a commercial bank or savings institution chartered by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or the United States.
2. That the proper officers of the Township shall be authorized to perform whatever other acts as shall be necessary under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or of the United States to establish and maintain such an account as shall have been aforesaid described.
3. It is the sense of the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Springfield that the proper officers of the Township shall be charged with choosing the appropriate federally insured obligations with commercial banks or savings institutions chartered by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or the United States and that the proper officers shall seek to obtain the highest possible return consistent with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania controlling First Class Townships.
